◆ **TAP** : planning to endorse by high level government.

◆ **Outstanding effort** : recom # 3.

- Designed elephant corridor to Protected Forest (2004)- @ Cardamom mountain rang.
- Working to establish other forest area to PFs- @ northeastern.
- Interconnecting Protected Forest and other conservation areas to TCL.

◆ **Funding** : Govn't commits to increase staff and funding to work for TCLs

◆ **Effort** : FA/MAFF and MoE supported preparation of TAP

◆ **International Support** :

- Immediate : assist to speed up for developing TAP, law enforcement, and capacity building.
- Long term : community engagement program, law enforcement, capacity building, research and monitoring, trans-boundary conservation cooperation.

## ◆ **Note relevance :**

- # 1 : kids think tigers are cool, but won't stop poaching, trading, habitat loss
  - ➔ Need fund for new campaign for esp, tiger
- # 4 : need more survey and analysis, then TAP will address
- # 7 : CITES is well in Cambodia, but illegal trade is in borders
  - ➔ Need skills, training, and equipments
- # 8 : same # 7.

## ◆ **Not relevance :**

- # 9 : no demand for tiger product in Cambodia
  - ➔ Fund for new campaign on especially tiger

## ◆ **Relevance :**

- # 2 : the law of forestry (2002), wildlife protection act (2007), PA law (2008), CITEST sub decree, designated 3 tiger hotspot area to PFs (2002).
  - ➔ Fund for more survey and analysis core tiger area, law enforcement, management, for establishment of other PFs.
- # 3 : same first slide
  - ➔ Same above

## ◆ **Relevance :**

- # 5 : no tiger-human conflict, local participate bring conservation success
  - ➔ Fund & development skills to increase local livelihood in/around TCLs
- # 6 : same above
- # 10 : after TAP is completed and endorsed, Cambodia is needed long-term support behaviors-change campaign.
  - ➔ Fund for developing TAP and long-term support for implementing

## ◆ **Relevance :**

- # 11 : ITTO transboundary project with Thailand & will to have Laos to participate
- # 12 : knowledge on NRM is limited
  - ➔ Further support on capacity building : scholarship, long and short term training, exchange study tour, meeting
- # 13 : In cooperation with WWF and WCS, trained scat sniffing dogs and camera traps are being used to survey tiger landscapes for potential source site of core tiger area
  - ➔ Need skills and trains

## ◆ **Relevance :**

- # 14 : Cambodia is always contributing proportional to its ability to conserve wildlife and protect habitats
  - ➔ Additional financing from donors
- # 15 : Cambodia is always considering and welcoming support from international donor community to conserve and protect biodiversity and habitats
